This program's quizzes can be found at https://www.readnquiz.com/home.aspx?id =32211; and the program also features book lists of many books which students can read. Each book has an online quiz that your child can take to earn points. Student's login info is the first letter of first name, plus last name (example: larchbold), with password *sts2020*.

While we do not endorse every book in *ReadnQuiz*'s list, there are many excellent books in the program. *We do recommend that you monitor your children's book choices and use of the Internet as they use this reading program.*

We hope *ReadnQuiz* proves to be helpful to those of you who have wished for a more formal summer reading program for your child. If you decide to sign up your child for this program, be sure to print out and submit to his teacher an individual quiz-score report at the end of summer. Students who are ready to read 3rd grade-level books may, of course, also be read from Saint Timo-thy's Accelerated Reading Lists.

As always, keep a list of all the books your child reads (or that you read to him) during the summer. Ask your child questions to help him articulate the content and flow of the book. Use the blanks below for the books your child reads. We love to see these reading lists in the fall, though they are not required for credit, as in the older grades.
